

Guidelines for authors for submission of papers to IWSM/MetriKon 2010

The languages of the conference IWSM/MetriKon 2010 are German and English.

Short version

Please submit a short version / extended abstract of your paper for the IWSM/MetriKon 2010. On the basis of submitted contributions, the program committee decides about the acceptance or rejection of each contribution.

The submission shall be conformant to the following requirements:

- length approx. 2-4 pages in format DIN A4
- avoid unnecessary indication of authors and their companies, focus rather on technical contents
- **important!** To facilitate the review of contributions by the program committee, your short version shall cover the following aspects:
 - Problem definition / challenge / context of your work
 - Methodology applied / deployment / innovation
 - Results / experiences / conclusion / outlook
 - Related work and references

In addition, please provide the following information on a separate sheet:

- Title of the article
- Up to 4 aspects which are important for the auditor
- Up to 5 keywords which characterize the article's content (see topics in Call for Papers)
- The names of the co-authors
- A short curriculum vitae from main author, possibly also from co-authors
- Company / Institute name and address (Postal, Telephone, Telefax, Email)
- Address of the author (Postal, Telephone, Telefax, Email)

Long version

The final long version of your accepted paper needs to be created by using the format specifications developed by DASMA and following the rules described therein. You will find the templates for the word processors Word, OpenOffice, LaTeX, and FrameMaker on the IWSM/MetriKon website at <<http://www.metrikon.de>>.

The following information should be given in the header of the article:

- Title of the article
- Names of all authors as well as Email address, further contact indications are allowed
- An abstract which resumes the content of the article clearly and briefly
- If possible a translation of the abstract into the other conference language
- Up to 5 key words which characterize the content of the article

Further mandatory specifications to be followed are given in the above mentioned format specifications.

The articles are to be submitted electronically in pdf format which is suitable for the pre-press. Preferably the pdf format should be created compatible to Adobe Acrobat 7. Alternatively you may use PostScript format which is generated by a generic PostScript driver. The accepted articles will not be revised editorially. In order to obtain a uniform appearance of the conference transcript it is therefore necessary to fully comply with the above mentioned format specifications.

By submitting a contribution the authors affirm that the article has not already been published elsewhere nor been submitted to a journal or to another conference and that at least one of the authors will register for the conference and ensure paper presentation. They also agree to the publishing of their articles in a conference transcript and on the websites of the organisers of IWSM/MetriKon 2010.

Presentation

The presentation must not exceed the duration of 30 or 45 min, assigned by the program committee per presentation. Overhead projector and beamer will be available. Additionally a PC with Power Point, OpenOfficeImpress and Acrobat-Reader will be provided.
